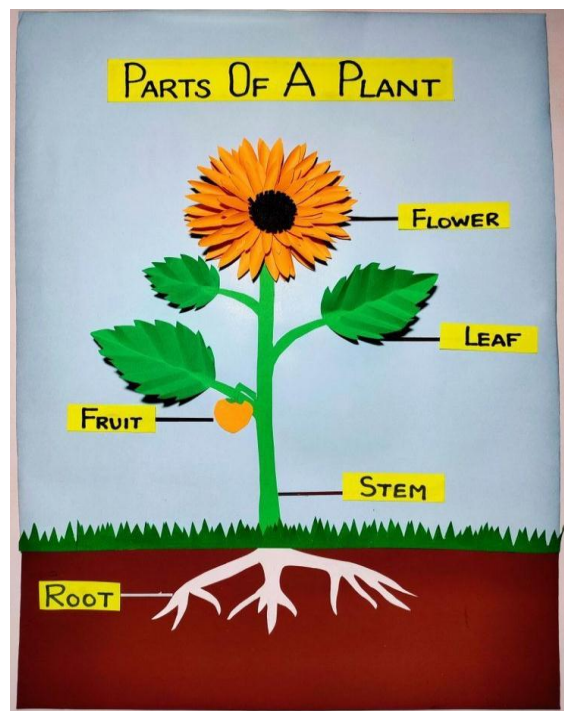
Topic: Parts of a Plant Using Origami Paper
